

**OFF-LICENCE**

Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

**Pursuant** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), Whitikahu Winery Limited is authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises situated at 429 Whitikahu Road Whitikahu and known as www.blueland.co.nz, to any person for consumption off the premises, to deliver it somewhere else, and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

**Conditions**

- (a) The licence shall be endorsed under section 40 of the Act.
- (b) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
- (c) While section 49 of the Act applies to this licence alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:

**Monday to Sunday 8.00am to 8.00pm**

- (d) The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - (i) Display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
  - (ii) Request age declaration from all customers before orders are placed and after sale is completed in accordance with regulation 14 of Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013.
- (e) The following information must be displayed on the internet site in a prominent place, in any catalogue used by the licence holder and on every receipt issued for any alcohol sold via the internet site:
  - (i) The licence holder's name, the licence number and the date on which the licence expires.
- (f) The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the management of the premises are observed:
  - (i) All staff will be trained in their responsibilities under the Act.
- (g) The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorised on the premises generally. The premises situated at 429 Whitikahu Road, Whitikahu are more precisely identified in a plan date stamped as received by the Waikato District Licensing Committee on 23 February 2017.

**Display of Licence**

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Whitikahu is designated as the principal entrance.

**Duration**

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force-

- (a) until its expiry date detailed below; OR
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence expires, until the close of the period 3 years after the expiry date.
